

How to get to Kingswood School - SS16 5DE



Basildon can be reached by A127 (from A12 or M25) or A13 (from East London or Dartford river crossing M25). Use the A176 from the A13 or A127. At Basildon Town Centre take Southernhay, pass the station on your right and take the next right under a bridge into Clay Hill Road. Take the second left at Papworth Trust and the entrance to the car park is from second right, Terling.

Kingswood School

By rail Basildon is on the Fenchurch St. to Southend line. From the station turn right onto Southerhay and follow the railway line, then as above.
